Volunteer agreement:

I will not attempt to contact young people I meet at FYC outside of FYC, or when I no longer volunteer at FYC.

I will inform the relevant session leader if I am unable to attend, and if possible, in advance give some notice if unable to continue volunteering.

I will raise any issue of concern relating to my volunteering with the session leader to be able to meet the demands of the work without risk to health.
